Street Boulder

Regulations

Street Boulder is a sport climbing event that takes place in the historic center of Serra San Quirico (AN), using “climbable” walls previously identified by our route setters. The climbing discipline involved is bouldering, which is a type of rope-free climbing reaching, in some cases, a maximum height of four meters (TOP). Falls are cushioned by special mats called **crash pads** and monitored by spotters.

The event takes place on short climbing routes, known as problems, blocs, or boulders, to be climbed without a rope, with **crash pads** placed in advance (to reduce the risk of injuries) along the pre-set routes within the walls of the town. All participants must have appropriate equipment for safe bouldering: at least one **crash pad** and one **headlamp** every two people and **climbing shoes** suitable for sport climbing. People who do not meet the safety requirements will be excluded from the event and immediately asked to leave. Participants must spot each other to prevent injuries. In exceptional cases, during the event, the organizers may decide to close or cancel one or more problems to protect athletes' safety or preserve the integrity of the wall.

The boulder zones available to participants are indicated on the map provided at the InfoPoint upon registration. Problems are marked with a numbered image showing the route. Difficulties range from easiest to hardest, based on the color assigned by the route setter. To validate a climb, participants must start with both hands on the Start or Sit-Start hold and, after lifting their feet off the ground, must reach the Top, holding the final hold for at least 3 seconds.





Note: Children **under the age of 10** are only allowed to attempt **YELLOW** and **WHITE** problems.

Points Assigned to the 80 Contest Problems – 2025



Note: The points for each problem will be divided by the number of participants who complete it. Anyone who completes all RED problems will automatically be credited for all YELLOW and WHITE problems

Color Points

 Yellow	100 pts
 White	200 pts
 Green	350 pts
 Blue	500 pts
 Red	750 pts
 Black	1000 pts
